JUNIUS PUBLIC HEARING
JUNIUS TOWN HALL

ATTENDANCE: SUPERVISOR GREG WADHAMS, COUNCILMEN THOMAS DAVIS, C.ERNEST BROWNELL, RICHARD WADHAMS, JAMES PASTOS. ALSO IN ATTENDANCE WAS THE ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN SARAH BIERLEY AND ASSESSOR FOR THE TOWN PHIL GRISWOLD.

OPEN: SUPERVISOR WADHAMS OPEN TONIGHT PUBLIC HEARING ABOUT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT CONTRACT AT 7:00 WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. NO ONE IN ATTENDANCE HAD ANY QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS, SO AT THIS TIME THE HEARING CLOSED, AT 7:01PM.

REGULAR MEETING

ATTENDANCE WAS THE SAME MEMBERS.

THE REGULAR MEETING WAS OPENED AT 7:02. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE FIRE CONTRACT FOR 2017 AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WILL NOW RECEIVE \$100,000.00 FOR PROTECTION.

GUESTS: ROBERT SOLLENNE FROM USNY BANK SPOKE TO THE BOARD THEIR BANKING PROCEDURE. HE SPOKE BRIEFLY ABOUT THEIR SERVICES THEY CAN PROVIDE THE TOWN IF INTERESTED. NEXT UP WAS DARRIN RAMSEY FROM CLEAN ENERGY. HE SPOKE ABOUT A PROGRAM THAT WOULD HELP WITH UPGRADING STREET LIGHTS, CLEAN FLEETS SOLARIZING, AND ENERGY CODES FOR THE TOWN. SUPERVISOR WADHAMS SPOKE ABOUT WHAT A GREAT JOB ON THE PRESENTATION, BUT EXPLAINED THAT THIS IS SUCH A RURAL TOWN THAT MOST OF THAT DID NOT APPLY TO JUNIUS, BUT WOULD LOOK INTO IT FURTHER.

TOWN CLERK: THE MINUTES FROM LAST MONTH WAS APPROVED WITH A COUPLE OF CORRECTIONS WITH A MOTION FROM COUNCILMAN PATSOS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN DAVIS. THE MOTION DID PASS WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. THE MONTHLY REPORT SHOWED A TOTAL OF \$782.00 WITH THE TOWN SHARE BEING \$777.00. COUNCILMAN PATSOS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT AND WITH COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. ALSO AT THIS TIME THE TOWN CLERK TURNED IN THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE OFFICE SHOWING TOTAL DISBURSEMENTS OF \$3,633.80 AND THE TOWN SHARE WAS \$3,152.80. MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT CAME FROM COUNCILMAN BROWNELL AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

SEWER: NOT MUCH TO REPORT. THERE WAS ONE ALARM AT THE PUMP STATION. OTHERWISE THE PLANT IS RUNNING SMOOTHLY.

HIGHWAY: THE SUPERINTENDENT INFORMED THE BOARD THAT 98% OF THE STRUCTURAL PART OF THE NEW HIGHWAY BARN IS COMPLETED. HE WILL BE SPEAKING TO NYSEG ABOUT THE TWO POLES THAT HAVE NOT BEEN UPGRADED ON DUBLIN ROAD WHEN ALL THE OTHERS WERE. THERE WAS A MAILBOX/SHOULDER ISSUE ON SMITH ROAD, THAT HE HAD WORKED ON. HE ALSO REPORTED THAT THERE IS \$42,347.93 LEFT OVER FROM LAST YEAR THAT CAN BE UTILIZED TOWARD THE BUILDING PROJECT IF NEEDED. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT AND WITH COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

TOWN HALL/ BUILDING: STILL TRYING TO GET SOME PRICES FOR FIXING THE BACK DOOR FRAME.

DCO: COUPLE OF BARKING DOGS COMPLAINTS, OTHERWISE QUITE. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

PLANNING BOARD: AT THIS TIME, TOM HICKS REPORTED THAT THEY DID NOT HOLD A MEETING LAST MONTH. MR. HICKS WILL IS OUT OF TOWN FOR 2 OR 3 MONTHS. LINDA MOTT WILL ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

ASSESSOR: THE ASSESSOR HAND OUT HIS WRITTEN REPORT. THINGS ARE RUNNING SMOOTHLY IN HIS OFFICE. CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIRMENTS AND KEEPING UP TO DATE ON DEEDS AND OTHER MONTHLY DUTIES. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO PASS, AND WITH COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE SECOND WHICH CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

OLD BILL: A BILL FROM THE OUTLET CENTER FOR REPAIRS THAT THE TOWN PAID FOR WAS MOTION TO SEND THE BILL TO THE OUTLET CENTER FOR \$7,516.80 AS IT IS THEIR RESPONSIBILITY. THE MOTION CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN PATSOS. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

VOUCHERS: GENERAL FUND V#1-29 FOR \$97,675.77 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

HIGHWAY FUND V#1-8 \$9,434.40 MOTION TO PAY CAME FROM COUNCILMAN PATSOS AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER1 V#1-6 \$3,066.80 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN DAVIS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

SEWER V#1-5 \$4,812.14 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN DAVIS. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

ADJOURN: MOTION TO ADJOURN TONIGHTS MEETING AT 8:05 P.M. CAME FROM COUNCILMAN DAVIS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN PATSOS, WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED.
