Attendance: Supervisor Brownell, Councilmen Davis, Black, Wadhams, Patsos.

Open: Supervisor Brownell opened the regular monthly meeting right after the conclusion of the reorganize meeting.

Town Clerk: The minutes were not completed. The report showed a total disbursement of \$832.00 with the Town share being \$797.00. Councilman Patsos made the motion to accept the report and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.

Water: Payment to Geneva resolution was table.

Highway: Busy doing repairs, they did swap out 52 pieces of pipe from water district 3.

Assessor: The county and town bills went out. This generates a lot of calls for him. He no longer handles the Star Enhancement Program; the State is now doing it. The re-val is coming along fine still.

Old/New: Councilman Wadhams made a motion to publish and hold a Public hearing on the Tax cap law and with Councilman Davis making the second, all members were in favor by roll call.

Councilman Patsos made the motion to hold a public hearing for the 2020 fire contract in the amount of \$108,450.00 and with Councilman Wadhams making the second the motion carried with all members in favor by roll call.

Intermuniciple Agreement: Making the motion for \$2000.00 came from Councilman Wadhams and with Councilman Black making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.

Transfers: A temporary transfer of \$35,000.00 from the General Fund to the Highway fund to cover expenses due to the Chips check of \$95,000.00 State check has not been delivered here. Councilman Patsos made the motion to transfer said funds. Councilman Wadhams made the second which carried with all members in favor.

Bills: General fund V# 1-19 \$37,042.76

Highway fund V#1-4 \$29,654.00

Capital Project V#1-3 \$114,138.47

Water2 fund V#1-\$525.00

Water 1 fund V#1-5 \$1,594.78

All of the above bills were paid by a motion from Councilman Patsos and second by Councilman Wadhams, the motion passed with all members in favor.

Adjourn: Councilman Patsos made the motion at 8:00 to adjourn the meeting and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.
