Regular meeting  
Junius Town Board

Attendance: Supervisor C.Ernest Brownell, Councilmen Thomas Davis, Kyle Black, Richard Wadhams and James Patsos.

Open: The Supervisor open this evenings meeting with the pledge of allegiance. He opened the floor for any questions. Greg Wadhams. Representing the Junius Volunteer Fire Department, inquired if they had any questions regarding the budget request they handed in. The board was in agreement did not have any questions.

Town Clerk: The monthly minutes were motioned to be accepted as written by Councilman Davis, with Councilman Patsos making the second, the motion passed with all members in favor.  
The Clerk's monthly report showed a total disbursement of \$549.00, with the Town retaining \$436.00 was motion to accept by Councilman Patsos and seconded by Councilman Davis. The motion carried with all members in favor. The Clerk mentioned The Tea House on Route 318 is filing for a liquor license. The Tea House and Mr. Martin have been told that they cannot hook up to the sewer by the County.

Sewer: The trailer and the tank are still on the property it was reported.

Water: Things are moving along, they might have to have another construction meeting sometime soon.

Highway: The department has been extremely busy with help cleaning up the Sewer Plant, working on the Water III line and doing some shoulders and with some help from neighboring Towns.

Building: Councilman Davis will check into why there is an awful sewer odor in all areas of the building.

Planning Board: Other than a few typo's, the new Sign Law is ready for public review and filing.  
Councilman Black made the motion to hold a Public Hearing on November 20, 2019 at 7:00 prior to the regular meeting. Councilman Wadhams made the second which carried with all members in favor.

Assessor: The Star exemption checks are filtering out. He is still working on the Reval and answering a lot of calls this past month.

Financial Transfers: Highway transferred \$18,244.92 Funds from Account numbers DA5110.1, DA5110.4, DA5130.2 and DA5142.4 to Da5112.1 and DA5130.4 Motion by Councilman Black and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.

Water fund SW-8320.41 \$11,000.00 to SW1-8320.4 was motion to transfer funds came from Councilman Black and making the second was Councilman Davis. The motion carried with all members in favor.

Notice: Councilman Davis made the motion to hold a public hearing on the 2020 budget on November 13, 2019 at 7:00. Councilman Patsos made the second, which carried with all members in favor.
