

Junius Town Board  
Regular Meeting  
Junius Town Hall  
December 16, 2020

Attendance: Supervisor Ernest Brownell, Councilmen Thomas Davis, James Patsos and Richard Wadhams.

Absent: Councilman Kyle Black

Open: Supervisor Brownell opened the meeting with the pledge of Allegiance. After the Pledge, he informed the board that the CHIPS money from 2019 came in finally. It was delayed because the Stat had sent the check to a former Supervisor address and he sent it back because he was not the supervisor, rather than just bring it to the Town Hall. The Town also received the State aid check.

Town Clerk: Councilman Patsos made the motion to accept the Town Clerk minutes from last month minutes as written and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.

The Town Clerk's report showed a total disbursement of \$96.00 with the Town share being \$81.00. With Councilman Davis making the motion to accept said report and with Councilman Wadhams making the second, the motion was carried with all members in favor.

Water: Resolution to increase Water District 3 by \$82,000.00 Motion to do so came from Councilman Wadhams, which was seconded by Councilman Patsos. Also, at the same time, a motion to hold a public hearing on January 6, 2021 at 6:00, prior to the re-organizational meeting. The public hearing was motion by Councilman Davis and seconded by Councilman Wadhams. Both motions carried with all members in favor. At this time, the board discussed the matter of B&B Underground. They wanted \$1,962.84 for the repairs done on the water line after their work failed. Councilman Wadhams motion not to pay them but to create an invoice from us for \$6,750.00 for the extra work the Town had to do to repair said line. Councilman Davis seconded the motion. All members were in favor of the motion.

USDA Cost Amendment Authorization Resolution to amend \$25,000.00 came from Councilman Wadhams and the second came from Councilman Patsos. The motion passed with all members in favor.

Highway: The Town Superintendent would like to take \$65,000.00 out of the CHIPS money to put in the machinery fund. Councilman Patsos made a motion to do so, with Councilman Wadhams making the second. All members were in favor. The salt has been ordered. The department has been doing some repairs on the trucks and some mowing.

Assessor: The Assessor took a class on PILOT ADMINISTRATION. He now has all his credits.

Old/new: Councilman Wadhams made the motion to sign the contract for Water Supply Support Service, for districts 1,2 &3 Councilman Davis made the second which carried with all in favor.

Supervisor Brownell would like to have the comprehensive Plan and the budget on the Town website. Councilman Wadhams made the motion and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.
