MARCH 22, 2017
REGULAR MEETING
JUNIUS TOWN BOARD

ATTENDANCE: SUPERVISOR GREG WADHAMS, COUNCILMEN THOMAS DAVIS, JAMES PASTSO, C. ERNEST BROWNELL AND RICHARD WADHAMS. ATTORNEY REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE TOWN, RAJA SEKHARAN. THE ASSESSOR FOR THE TOWN, PHIL GRISWOLD.

OPEN: THE SUPERVISOR OPENED THE MEETING AT 7:00P.M LEADING THE BOARD WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. THE REGULAR MEETING THAT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE HELD ON MARCH 15, 2017 NEEDED TO BE CANCELED BECAUSE OF WEATHER.

GUEST: KYLE BLACK FOR SENECA MEADOWS CAME TO THE BOARD TO DISCUSS A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW REGARDING COUNTY OFFENSIVE NOXIOUS ODORS. HE EXPLAINED THAT THIS IS BENEFICIAL TO BOTH RESIDENCES AND THE LANDFILL. HE JUST WANTED TO ASK THE BOARD ON SUPPORTING THE LAW. IT HAS RECEIVED A LOT OF SUPPORT FROM OTHER MUNICIPALITIES, RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES.

TOWN CLERK: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT LAST MEETING MINUTES AS WRITTEN AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. THE CLERK'S REPORT SHOWED A TOTAL DISBURSEMENT OF \$32.00 WITH THE TOWN SHARE BEING \$27.00. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED. ALSO AT THIS TIME THE CLERK REPORTED THAT DARRYL SMITH NEEDED TO BE REAPPOINTED TO THE BOARD OF ASSESSMENTS. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO REAPPOINT MR. SMITH AND WITH COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER COMMITTEE: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL REPORTED THAT THE ELEVEN TESTS THAT HAVE BEEN DONE ON THE NEW WATER DISTRICT, NINE OF THEM HAVE FAILED. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SUPERVISOR TO RESIGN THE JOINT WATER PROJECT AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. IT WAS ALSO REPORTED THAT THE DEBT SERVICE FOR WATER DISTRICT ONE HAS BEEN PAID OFF.

HIGHWAY: SUPERINTENDANT FISK REPORTED ON THE STORM THAT HAPPENED LAST WEEK AND THE PLOWING THAT NEEDED TO BE DONE. HE ALSO REPORTED ON SOME REPAIRS MADE TO THE MACK TRUCK AND THE BUILDING IS JUST ABOUT COMPLETED. THE 2017 TOWN WIDE CLEAN UP DAYS WILL BE ON APRIL 28 AND 29, 2017. HE ALSO EXTENDED HIS GRATITUDE TO KYLE BLACK AND SENECA MEADOWS FOR WORKING WITH HIM ON THIS PROJECT, WHICH IN TURN HE RECEIVED A THANK YOU FROM THE BOARD FOR DOING THE CLEAN UP DAYS.

BUILDING: THERE WAS SOME DISCUSSION THAT THE PROPANE FUEL PRICES HAS GONE UP. IT WAS RECOMMENDED TO LOOK AROUND. IT SEEMS THAT THE COMPANY THAT THE TOWN USES DOES NOT FOLLOW THE OFFICE OF GOVERNMENT SERVICE PRICING AND WE ARE BEING OVER CHARGE. THEY WILL BE LOOKING INTO IT.

OTHER REPORTS: TONIGHT THERE WERE NOT ANY OTHER REPORTS TO BE HEARD.

BILLS: THE TOWN CLERK READ THE ABSTRACTS AS PRESENTED TO HER. GENERAL FUND WAS \$29,682.96 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN DAVIS. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.

HIGHWAY FUND \$ 7,991.69 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN PATSOS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.

SEWER \$4,841.71 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN DAVIS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.

WATER1 FUND WAS \$35,198.92 WAS MOTION BY COUNCILMAN DAVIS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.

ADJOURN: MOTION TO ADJOURN THE MEETING AT 8:05 P.M. CAME FROM COUNCILMAN DAVIS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.
