Councilman Black made a motion to close the hearing and open the regular meeting at 7:02pm. Councilman Patsos made the second which carried with all members in favor.

Regular board meeting

Open: The regular board meeting open immediately with the same members in attendance. The floor was opened.

Water District III: Supervisor Brownell spoke about checking banks regarding loan amounts, interest rates and associated cost for Water District III if needed. A Resolution for Establishing Towns of Junius Extension No.3 Water District (Parcels 1,2 and 3 Subject to Permissive Resolution was motion by Councilman Patsos moved that the Resolution be adopted and was seconded by Councilman Black, called for a roll call vote, which went as follows: Councilman Patsos-aye, Councilman Wadhams-aye, Councilman Black-aye Supervisor Brownell-aye and Councilman Davis-aye.

Town Clerk- Last month's minutes were motion by Councilman Patsos to accept and was seconded by Councilman Davis. The motion carried with all members in favor. The Town Clerk report showed a total disbursement of \$67.00 with the Town share be \$60.00. Motion to accept the report came from Councilman Patsos and the second came from Councilman Black, with all members in favor the motion carried.

Water: Two fire hydrants need replacing and Councilman Black made the motion to purchase them and with Councilman Davis making the second, it carried with all members in favor.

Highway: The highway has been asked if anyone knows what the sewer rates will be, but it has not been decided yet. Regular plowing and salting has been done. Spectrum has been all thru the Town, they have caused some property damage installing the cable, and they intend to take care of the damage. The road to the sewer plant is in need of repair. The Superintendent also spoke about the Annual Clean up Days, which will be held on April 26 7:00am till 3:00pm., and again on Saturday, April 27 from 7:00am till 11:30pm.

Assessor: The Assessor reported that his field review has been done; there are 3 new homes in the Town. With the passing of Richard Lyons and the resignation from Chris Tarr, two new people were named for the Board of Assessment. They are Diane Hay and Theresa Dziekonski. Councilman Wadhams motion they be appointed and with Councilman Davis making the second the motion carried with all members in favor.

Tax Cap: Councilman Wadhams made the motion for the Local Law to override the tax levy limit for the 2020 budget if need be and with Councilman Black making the second; the motion was carried with all members in favor.
