March 17, 2021

Open: Supervisor Brownell open the meeting at 6:00 with the pledge of allegiance.

Town Clerk: Minutes from last month's meeting was motion to accept by Councilman Davis and the second came from Councilman Wadhams. The Town Clerk showed a total disbursement of \$79.00 with the town share being \$63.00 was motion to accept by Councilman Patsos and the second came from Councilman Black, which carried with all members in favor.

Highway: The Highway department have been busy with some clean up around town, removing trees and debris. The excavator needs some work, that will be going to Syracuse for repairs. Also, the Volvo needs work and that will be going to Rochester. The installed a new water pump at the town hall.

Sewer: Residents from the Town are upset that the County sewer line running thru their yards, is extremely high. Unfortunately, it is so high that some residents can not hook up to it, because of the cost.

New Business: Finger Lake's Community Broadband Network spoke with the Supervisor to give him a quote for internet, and 6 phones and program them. He is still waiting for a quote from Spectrum. No action was taken.

Due to Covid19, the Town has a new Infectious Disease/Pandemic Emergency Plan (PEP) that the board looked it over, and Councilman Wadhams motion to accept with the Supervisor discretion after reading up on the law, and with that being stated Councilman Davis made the second, which carried with all members in favor.

New antennas will be installed on the water tower to enhance 911 was motion to do so by Councilman Wadhams and seconded by Councilman Patsos, which carried with all

members in favor. It was decided to keep accepting job applications till the end of the month.
