Regular Meeting

Junius Town Hall

Attendance: Supervisor C. Ernest Brownell, Councilmen James Patsos and Thomas Davis.

Absent: Councilmen Richard Wadhams and Kyle Black.

Guest: Mitch Rowe and Peter Baker.

Open: Supervisor Brownell opened this evening's meeting with leading us to the pledge of allegiance.

Bills: Motion to have the bills paid first came from Councilman Patsos and with the second being made by Councilman Davis the motion carried with all in favor.

Pre-Pays: General Fund V#71-73 \$1,353.99

Highway Fund V#22 for \$2,009.06

Water District1 fund V#14 for \$828.56

Paying tonight: General Fund V#74-96 for \$4,505.81

Highway Fund V# 23-29 for \$14,771.95

Water District 1 Fund V#15-16 for \$482.53

Water District2 Fund V#5 for \$468.34

Water District 3 Fund V#19-24 for \$4,198.76

All the above motions were paid by a motion from Councilman Patsos and the second was made by Councilman Davis. All members were in favor.

Sewer: Seneca County Manager Mitch Rowe and Engineer Peter Baker were in attendance tonight to answer questions regarding the new Sewer District. They passed out a map from Grange Hall Road to Route 414. Peter baker stated that we already had an Intermunicipal Agreement in place. Supervisor Brownell explained to him that all of that was already discussed. Supervisor Brownell and Resident John Dendis wanted to know what kind of pumps the residents should use if they want to hook into the district. Mr. Baker stated that E1 pumps is what he recommends. John Dendis spoke about Goulds Pumps are another good alternative. After a brief discussion where Mr. Baker also agreed that the Goulds Pumps are just as good, but the bottom line is Mr. Baker recommends that the residents go with the E1 pumps. It is also recommended by him that a professional install the pumps. The also discussed whether to start a Town wide District. Right now, there are 5 customers interested to hooking up. Last meeting when Mitch Rowe was here there was talk about forming a Sewer board, possibly 2 from each town, and he will be working on that. Mr. Rowe also asked Mr. Baker if there is any grant funding to offset some of this hook up cost. He will be looking into that.

Town Clerk: The Town Clerk report showed a total disbursement of \$105.00 and the town share being \$75.50. Councilman Patsos made the motion to accept said report and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion passed with all members in favor. At this time Councilman Patsos made the

motion to accept last months minutes as written. Councilman Davis made the second which passed with all members in favor.

Water: The annual drinking report for 2020 has been filed.

Highway: They have been busy removing lots of trees. The pipe came in for the culvert crossings. Some new signs have been ordered and they are looking into a replacement Coverall cover for the salt shed, they are running about \$13,000.00. The Superintendent also reported it cost \$12,000.00 to repair the Mack.

Phones: They are stilling working on getting the system up and going.

New business: The Justice audit is completed and filed in the Town Clerks Office. Also at this time Supervisor Brownell signed the agreement with Williamson Law Book for software for the Supervisor Secretary.

Adjourn: The meeting adjourned at 7:15 with a motion from Councilman Davis and the second came from Councilman Patsos. All were in favor.
