Attendance: Supervisor Ernest Brownell. Councilmen Kyle Black, Thomas Davis, James Patsos and Richard Wadhams.

Others: Ed Boudreau, Finger Lakes Partners Insurance and Pat Nicolette from MRB

Open: The Supervisor started the meeting at 6:00 with the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Boudreau went first. He was here to speak with the Board about updating the Insurance. He had added the sheds which are now covered. Protected Service for work done on other roads not in the town. He passed some pamphlets out. He spoke about adding Cyber liability cover. After some discussion Councilman Black made a motion to go ahead with adding the coverage to the plan. Councilmen Davis made the second to said motion. All members were in favor of the addition.

Pat Nicoletta- Mr. Nicoletta brought in some resolutions to go over with the board.

First-Joint Water District No.3 change order authorization for V & B Underground Utilities Inc. to pay the agreed amount of \$1,962.84. Councilman Wadhams made the motion to pay and with Councilman Davis making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.

Second- Additional Legal Services Resolution. This resolution was to increase the amount paid to Riley & Graff not to exceed \$13,950.00. Councilman Wadhams made the motion to pass the resolution and with Councilman Patsos making the second, the motion carried with all members in favor.

Third- New Interest Increase Resolution. This resolution was that the Town has paid net interest for the Water District III in the amount of \$31,564.67 total for the Bond Anticipation Note (BAN). Motion was made by Councilman Patsos and with Councilman Black making the second the motion carried with all members in favor.

New- Councilman Black made the motion to send payment of \$14,325.42 to the Town of Geneva their part of the Water III. Councilman Wadhams made the second. The motion carried with all members in favor.

Open Floor: Coleen Smith introduced herself to the Board as she is running for Town Clerk in the upcoming Primary.

Highway- The department has been busy patching up roads. Cleaning brush up, replacing signs. Been looking into a cover for the Salt building, around \$13,000.00. Black topping will be starting soon. A utility pole had to be replaced. TJ Fisk had one available, they will bill the town.

Planning Board: The planning board sent a letter to Gregory Mayo Jr. regarding the sign that was put up that is currently in violation of the Town of Junius Sign Law. If the violations are not taken care of within thirty days of the letter, then there will be a fine of \$250.00. The Town Board appreciated the update.

Old: The phone and internet crew has not gotten back to Supervisor Brownell. He will follow up with them.

New: The Town Clerk announced that she filed for retirement from the job of Junius Court Clerk. A letter of resignation was emailed to all board members with an email address. The retirement was from the job of Court Clerk not to be confused regarding the Town Clerk position.

Adjourn: Councilman Davis made the motion to adjourn this evening meeting at 7:35. Councilman Patsos mad the second, which carried with all members in favor.
