

JUNE 21, 2017
REGULAR MEETING
JUNIUS TOWN HALL

ATTENDANCE: SUPERVISOR G.WADHAMS, COUNCILMEN DAVIS, BROWNELL, R.WADHAMS AND PATSOS. ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN RAJA SEKCHARAN AND GUEST SPEAKER STEVEN PATTON FROM USA PAYROLL WERE ALSO IN ATTENDANCE.

OPEN: SUPERVISOR WADHAMS STARTED THE MEETING AT 7:00P.M., BY LEADING WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. MR. PATTON FOR USA PAYROLL EXPLAINED TO THE BOARD WHAT HIS COMPANY DOES AND THE BENEFITS TO HAVING AN INDEPENDENT COMPANY DO THE PAYROLL. A SMALL DISCUSSION WAS HAD, AND HE THANKED THE BOARD FOR THEIR TIME. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

TOWN CLERK: TOTAL DISBURSEMENTS FOR THE MONTH WAS \$ 137.00 WITH THE TOWN RETAINING \$116.00. COUNCILMAN PATSOS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. ALSO AT THIS TIME COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT MINUTES AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL REPORTED THAT PAT NICOLLET SAID THE COMPTROLLER NEED ADDITIONAL PAPERWORK, THERE WAS AN ERROR. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL QUESTIONED IF THE HOLD UP MIGHT BE BECAUSE OF FINACIAL PAPERWORK NOT BEING FILED PROPERTY. SUPERVISOR WADHAMS SAID THAT IS NOT THE CASE. HE ALSO REPORTED THAT THE COUNTY NEEDS TO MOVE THREE PUMPS.

SEWER: COUNCILMAN WADHAMS REPORTED THINGS ARE RUNNING SMOOTHLY AT THE PLANT.

HIGHWAY: SUPERINTENDANT FISK REPORTED THAT THE HEAT AND AIRCONDITIONER ARE BOTH WORKING AT THE NEW BUILDING. THE FLOORING HAS TO BE DONE BEFORE INSTALLING THE COMMODE AND SINKS. FIRST MOWING HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND THEY PLAN ON STARTING THE SECOND ROUND. THE WEATHER HAS BEEN HINDERING ANY WORK ON THE ROADS AS IT HAS BEEN TO WET. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

BUILDING: COUNCILMAN DAVIS REPORTED THAT MR.AMIDON WILL BE ORDERING A NEW DOOR FOR THE TOWN HALL. THE OUTSIDE LIGHT ON THE POOL IS GOING ON AND OFF; NYSEG WILL TAKE CARE OF THAT.

DCO: WHILE IT HAS BEEN QUITE THIS PAST MONTH, THE WILL BE A WORKSHOP ON JULY 5, 2017 AT 7:00 AT THE TOWN HALL TO WORK ON A PROPOSED DOG CONTROL LAW. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MOTION TO HAVE THE WORK SHOP AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. COUNCILMAN DAVIS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

ASSESSOR: THE ASSESSOR HANDED IN HIS MONTHLY REPORT SHOWING THAT TWO PETITIONERS WERE PRESENT AT THE GRIEVANCE BOARD, WHICH WAS HELD ON JUNE 7, 2017. THE FINAL ROLL WILL BE TRANSMITTED TO THE COUNTY AND A COPY TO THE TOWN CLERK ON JULY 1ST. COUNCILMAN

BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SEOCND, THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

OLD BUSINESS: THREE PEOPLE WERE INTERVIEW FOR THE SUPERVISOR CLERK. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO HIRE DENISE DARCANGELIS AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. PAY WILL BE ADJUSTED ACCORDINGLY TO THE EXTREA WORK.

BILLS: GENERAL FUND: V #103-127 FOR \$35,491.57. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO PAY AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS THE MOTION CARRIE WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

HIGHWAY FUND: V #36-45 FOR \$9,954.35. COUNCILMAN PATSOS MADE THE MOTION TO PAY AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER FUND: V # 24-27 FOR \$31,772.16 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN DAVIS, WHIGH CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

SEWER FUND: V# 21-28 FOR \$604.81 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN DAVIS AND MAKING THE SECOND WAS COUNCILMAN PATSOS, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

ADJOURN: MOTION TO ADJOURN CAME AT 8:20 P.M. BY COUNCILMAN PATSOS AND MAKING THE SECOND WAD COUNCILMAN DAVIS. WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED.
