June 19, 2019

Attendance: Supervisor C.Ernest Brownell, Councilmen Richard Wadhams, James Patsos, Thomas Davis.
Absent was Councilman Kyle Black.

Open: Supervisor Brownell opened the meeting at 7:05 with the Pledge of Allegiance. The floor was opened, yet no one had anything to ask.

Town Clerk: Monthly report showed a totaled disbursement of \$129.00 with the Town share being \$106.00. Supervisor asked if everyone had read last month's minutes, all had and with Councilman Wadhams making the motion to accept the minutes. Councilman Patsos seconding, the motion carried with all members in favor. The Town Clerk spoke briefly about a propane salesman had visited and would like to talk about possibly changing companies. Supervisor Brownell will follow up.

MRB: Pat Nicoletta spoke that they are ready to put the bid out for Water District III. The bid opening will be July 9, 2019 at the Town Hall at 1:00. There was a Compliance Review Employee Questionnaire that needed to be filled out by everyone for Rural Development. The Superintendent spoke about a new hire to work on the Water District II. At some point one of the men will have to come off the line and get back to Town Highway Jobs. With only two fulltime employees, both working on the line, it's finally nice out and the Town has their jobs that need to be done, there are not enough hours or man power to keep things up. Councilman Wadhams made the motion to Statewide Aquastore inspect and repair the water tower for \$2200.00. Councilman Patsos made the second, which carried with all members in favor.

Sewer: Supervisor Brownell and Councilman Wadhams inspected the Sewer Department. Just a little clean up around there is left. The County is waiting on the Mall attorneys to get the sewer to get the Sewer flowing.

Highway: The very wet weather we have been having is making it hard to get out and mow. All Towns are behind on the mowing for the same reason.

DCO: The Town Kennel was inspected and no problems were found.

Planning: The Planning board is waiting the ok to proceed on the sign ordinance.

Assessor: The Assessor gave is report noting that everything is running smooth. He will try to get ahold of one of the Board of Review members that did not show up on Grievance day.
