Assessor Report: Phil Griswold reported on Grievance Day that they had 1 petitioner who failed to show up to the Board of Assessment review. The new member will be needed by May 2023. Also, receiving many calls about the Governors' Homeowner's rebate checks. It's based on income and the STAR program.

Old BUSINESS:

Regarding the \$7900 bill from Allied CPA, Councilman Kyle Black spoke with Diana Smith from MRB. She reviewed all the information and has offered to pay half of the \$7200 bill and talk with the auditors to see if they will delete the other half of the bill.

Councilman Kyle Black made a motion to accept MRB taking care of half of the bill and approaching the Audit firm to take care of the other half. Motioned seconded by Councilman Randy Wadhams.
