Attendance: Supervisor Ernest Brownell, Councilmen Tom Davis, Kyle Black and James Pastos.

Open: Tonight's meeting began at 7:00pm with the Supervisor leading with the pledge of allegiance. The floor was opened; no one wanted to address the board.

Town Clerk: Councilman Patsos made the motion to accept last month's minutes as written and with Councilman Davis made the second, which carried with all members in favor. The monthly report for the Town Clerk was a total disbursement of \$540.00 with the town share being \$441.00. Councilman Davis made the motion to accept said report and with Councilman Pastos making the second which was carried with all members in favor.

Water Report: Joint Water Project Water District No. 3 Regarding Long Side Water Services: Bid Authorization Resolution authorize the MRB Group to prepare the bidding documents, was motion by Councilman James Pastos, Councilman Kyle Black seconded the motion which carried with all members in favor.

Sewer Report: The plant has been closed. County needs to decommission it.

Highway Report: Superintendent Fisk reported that the department did some shimming and blacktop several roads. He also reported that some of the material for the waterline has been coming in, pipe is on premises.

Planning Board: The Sign Ordinance is ready to be signed, Councilman Pastos made the motion to proceed and with Councilman Davis making the second which was passed with all members in favor.

Assessor Report: The Assessor attended a class on Ethics in Batavia. Along with his daily work he has been working with the Reval Company.

Other: Councilman Black motion to have the surplus that has been left in the building for many years be declares surplus for sale or donate. Councilman Patsos made the second which carried with all members in favor.

Village of Waterloo new Water Contract was motion to table by Supervisor Brownell and seconded by Councilman Davis. The motion passed with all members in favor.

Propane: Motion to accept Superior Plus Propane (formally Phelps Sungas) as the supplier for all Town Buildings at a rate of \$1.22 a gallon was brought up by Councilman Patsos and the second came from Councilman Davis. The motion carried with all members in favor.
