Regular Meeting
Junius Town Hall

Attendance: Supervisor C. Ernest Brownell, Councilmen Kyle Black, James Patsos and Richard Wadhams.
Absent Councilman Thomas Davis.
Special Guest Assemblyman Jeff Gallahan.

Open: The Supervisor open the meeting at 6:00 with the pledge of allegiance. We had the pleasure to have Assemblyman Jeff Gallahan present and he spoke about getting a hold of him if needed. Wanted to see one of our meetings and what help he could be if needed.

Councilman Black made the motion to pay all the bills. Councilman Patsos made the second which carried with all members in favor.

Town Clerk: The month report showed a total disbursement of \$138.00 with the Town share being \$114.00, which was motion to accept said report by Councilman Patsos and the second came from Councilman Black. The motion carried with all members in favor.

Water: Pat Nicolletta spoke about they are waiting on a check from the State still. Also, if there are any outstanding bills from creating Water District 3, to send them to him. There will be a meeting with the engineers, Thruway Authority and the engineer on Friday.

Highway: The employees have been busy help with the Water District. The repair money fund for the equipment is way down due to many repairs to all the Town trucks. There is an estimate for a 2022 Chevy 3500 from Bill Crams for \$39,882. Driveways have been restored after culverts work.

Planning: Alan Martin will be attending planning meeting next month.

Assessment: The assessor spoke about the adoption of a Local Law of the Town of Junius for the year 2021 entitled "A Local Law to Provide That Exemption for Sale of Solar or Wind Energy System and For Farm Waste Energy System Pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 487 shall Not be Applicable Within the Town of Junius. The town will hold a public hearing on the 20th of October prior to the regular meeting at 6:00. Right after that hearing, there will be a public hearing regarding opting in or out of the Town share of Marijuana Sales within the Town of Junius.

Adjournment: The motion to adjourn came from Councilman Patsos at 6:30. Councilman Wadhams made the second which carried with all members in favor.
