On Mills Road, a tractor trailer damaged the side of the road. The highway department has about 600 feet of broken shoulders that they will work on getting repaired.

Supervisor Brownell received a complaint that the Burgess Road sign is missing.

There is a dumpster at the highway barns for the garbage and miscellaneous items they pick up alongside the road.
